(Monterey, CA)

A versatile white wine that is light and refreshing, delicately fruity & perfumed, yet dry & lip-smacking brisk & crisp.

2 oz. Albarino, Cambiata 2014 \$7.00
(Monterey, CA)

A delicately exotic, lush, well textured white grown on wind-pounded hillsides down in Monterey.

2 oz. Viognier, Clendenen Family 2013 \$8.95
(Santa Barbara, CA)

A “quietly” exotic, wonderfully pure, classy, tasty, worldly Santa Barbara-n standout.

“RUSTIC REDS” \$10.00

Here are some of our most FAVORITE RUSTIC RED produces that you should try!--- It is more about deliciousness, food-friendly, with elegance and depth.

“COOL CLIMATE CHARDS” \$13.00

When chardonnay is complimented with a bit of cool by altitude, or by climate conditions, this can really produce some great wines! Here are 3 of our FAVORITE Chardonnays grown in “Cool Climate Terriors”.

Burgundian style, with hints of butter brioche, and tropical fruits, this wine is absolutely delicious and stylish!

(France)

A floral, stony Chardonnay from Chablis Master Roland Lavantureux. Since the estate’s founding in 1978, Roland has kept production minimal, using only the fruit he deems ready.

2 oz. Costa de Oro “Santa Barbara ” \$9.95
Chardonnay 2013 (Santa Barbara, CA)

This beautiful Santa Barbara county chardonnay exhibits a beautiful nose of lemon and apricot fruit, with caramel, butterscotch, and yeasty undertone.
